## Scholarships

The University of Nottingham Malaysia Campus grants scholarships to deserving and academically excellent students in recognition of their achievements. Applicants are selected based on their academic achievements, leadership qualities and the socio-economic status of their family.

### High Achievers' Scholarships

High Achievers' Scholarships (HAS) are for Malaysian students only and are available on an automatic basis to all academically-qualified students applying for foundation and undergraduate programmes.

### HAS for foundation students

A scholarship equivalent to a 25% reduction of the tuition fee is automatically awarded to all students who have:

- obtained 7 A's<sup>^</sup> in their SPM/GCSE

There will be additional scholarships for students who:

- obtained 9 to 10 A's<sup>^</sup> in SPM/GCSE — an additional 5% is given on top of the 25% reduction (total: 30%)
- obtained 11 to 12 A's<sup>^</sup> or more in SPM/GCSE — an additional 10% is given on top of the 25% reduction (total: 35%)

The HAS is available to students who apply for any of the three-semester foundation year programmes in arts and education, business, engineering or science.

### HAS for undergraduate programme students

An automatic HAS equivalent to 25% of the tuition fee will be awarded to students satisfying the criteria outlined below. The HAS is awarded for only one academic year and is not applicable for the progressing academic years. Students may subsequently be eligible at the point of progression for the Dean's Excellence Scholarship (DES).

### General criteria:

- A level: 3A's<sup>^</sup>, excluding general studies
- STPM: 3A's, excluding general studies (A- will not be considered as an equivalent to an A)
- UEC: 7A's<sup>^</sup>, including language options

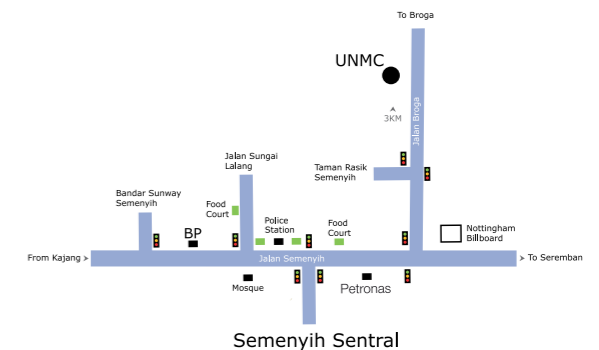
